

The Hematology-Oncology service at Hôpital Saint-Louis (AP-HP, University of Paris, France), part of the department of hematology and immunology, is seeking a junior hematologist to join as a Contractual Hospital Practitioner (PHC), with the possibility of advancement to a permanent Hospital Practitioner (PH) position within two years.

The service specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of lymphomas and chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL). Its activities include inpatient care, day hospital services, and outpatient clinics, with a strong commitment to clinical and translational research. Furthermore, it holds specialized accreditations including LRIPH (authorized center for clinical research in humans, ARS 2023) and JACIE accreditation, an international benchmark for transplant programs. It is also a leading center for CAR-T cell therapies and bispecific antibodies.

Since 2022, the service has participated in 73 active clinical trials, with about 70 patients treated with CAR-T every year and an increasing number with bispecific antibodies, placing it among the leading European centers in cell immunotherapy.

**Desired profile:** Hematology specialist (European or French recognized qualification), with an interest in clinical practice and research. A high level of French is not required (but a commitment to improvement is essential).

**Position:** Clinical Physician with the possibility of becoming a permanent Physician .

**Salary:** initially about 4500 € gross monthly base salary + additional allowances for on-call shifts and for morning attendance on weekends/holidays.

**Vacation:** 25 working days + 20 days (of “reduced working hours”) every year
